FRASASSI CAVES
SUMMER IN A MAGICAL PLACE IN THE HEART OF THE EARTH

From Monday 18 May, the Frasassi Caves are open again every day to accommodate tourists on an underground route that is the most admired and appreciated in Italy.

The Frasassi Consortium, the body that manages the underground complex, has passed the rules for entering and using the route.

A strong sign of resilience and a restart, for tourism in the name of safety.

«The summer started under the best auspices - affirms the lawyer Marco Filipponi, mayor of Genga - with a progressively growing trend. Clear sign of a tourism that sees the interior areas among the most popular. The territory of Genga with its vast offer, first of all the marvelous Frasassi Caves, has promptly answered a question that finds a structured and level destination in these areas».

«We can safely say that our territories, characterized by wide open spaces, allow tourists to be able to appreciate the landscape and environmental beauties in complete safety - specifies the engineer Lorenzo Burzacca, Vice President of the Frasassi Consortium - so much so that, the Frasassi area is confirmed as a favorite destination for hikers, vacationers and families».

In fact, the whole area of the Gola della Rossa and Frasassi Park enjoys suggestive panoramic points that can be reached through paths that can guarantee the adequate distance required.

- The Consortium has drawn up the regulation of tourist use, which will remain in force until new and further modifications of the latest decrees issued by the Government.
- Visits are active which allow you to visit the cave in conditions of full respect for social distancing
- The entrance ticket can be purchased both online and on site (ticket office in La Cuna)
- In the case of online purchase, the entrance coupon will be printed in advance by the customer and delivered directly to the entrance, or shown to the staff located at the entrance via mobile phone download, bypassing in each case the stop at the ticket office;
- The holder of the entrance ticket can use the car park in the La Cuna area, and then walk towards the entrance (1300m), or use the car park in San Vittore di Genga, and continue on foot (600m), or take advantage of the FREE SHUTTLE BUS always departing from the car park in the La Cuna area.
- The booking time is equal to the departure time of the FREE SHUTTLE BUS, while the entry time to the cave is about 10 minutes later;

- The holder of the entrance ticket must necessarily have a mask: wear it both while waiting at the ticket office, in the shuttle bus and during the visit to the cave
- To ensure adequate safety distancing, visiting groups will be reduced in the number of components
- The visitor's body temperature will be measured at the entrance to the caves with a thermoscanner. With temperatures above 37.5 ° it will not be possible to visit the Caves and the customer will be kindly invited to leave the entrance
- The price of the entrance ticket will remain unchanged: 18 euro full (+ dp); 15 euro reduced (+ dp); 12 euros from six to fourteen years (+ dp); free up to six years
